Though there are already programs out there focusing on water in plastic bottles, we considered the impact 3208 members in District 5450's 66 clubs could have if they all stopped buying bottled water. If other districts follow our lead, think about the clout 1.2 million Rotarians in 33,000 clubs worldwide could have if they all stopped using bottled water.
